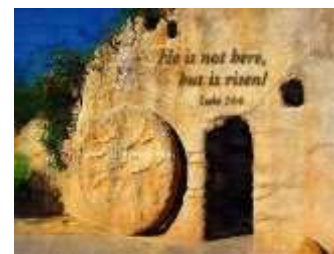
April 21 – Easter Sunday. Services times will be:
