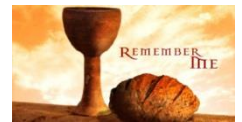


HOLY WEEK AT CGS



April 14 – Palm Sunday - Lux in Tenebris: Lenten Reflections featuring the Requiem for the Living by Dan Forrest Choir Concert at 4:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary. Reception following in Jordan Hall. The concert will feature the CGS Choir, Holy Family Catholic Church, and the Youth Christian Orchestra of Glendale. The concert will also be performed April 6, 7:30 p.m., at Holy Family Catholic Church.

April 18 – Holy Thursday. Good Shepherd Children’s Center closed. A Maundy Thursday Communion Service will be held at 7:00 p.m. in our Chapel.

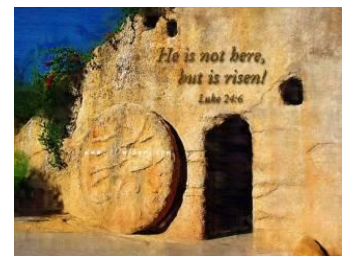
