We do it all in 30 minutes so there is plenty of time to

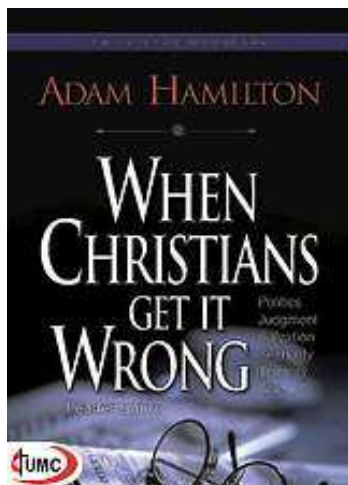
- follow a class with praise

Join the spring CGS Book Study featuring “*WHEN CHRISTIANS GET IT WRONG*” by Adam Hamilton, pastor of United Methodist Church of the Resurrection.

ABOUT THE BOOK--With his familiar style, Pastor Hamilton tackles such issues as judging others, condemning people of other faiths, rejecting science, injecting politics into faith, and being anti-homosexual. The book and discussions will address the “how’s” and “why’s” of Christians getting it wrong with Pastor Adam providing suggestions on how we Christians can get it right when it comes to being Christ in the world. 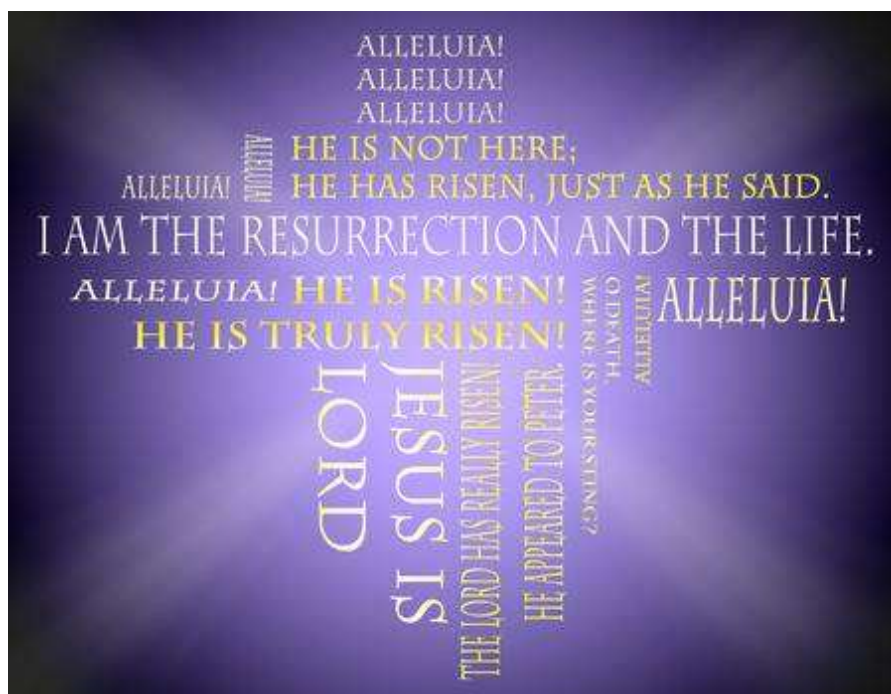
