
Please keep all those previously mentioned in your prayers. If you or a loved one needs to be added to the prayer chain or the newsletter prayer list, please let the church office know.

Foundation Grants

The Church of the Good Shepherd Foundation Inc. approved 16 grants in 2019 - our first full year since changing the grant process from a single grant period to accepting requests all year-round. The total amount of money to fund these 2019 grants was over \$44,000.

In May of 1945 Church of the Good Shepherd held its first service, at the Holly Avenue School Auditorium. Within 10 weeks, a Sanctuary Crusade began to save money for the Chapel, that was built in 1947. The church continued to grow and the Sanctuary was built in 1957 to accommodate the larger congregation.

In celebration of our 75 years of Christian Ministry and Mission, we are planning several opportunities to celebrate this milestone. Pastor Eva's Message

On Saturday, Feb. 8th, we had the All Church Clean Up day. It was wonderful to



have 23 people help out in many areas of the church: from the chapel, to the sanctuary and outer hallway rafters, to Jordan Hall, to the library, to parking lot landscaping. While I was present at the church for meetings as well, I was able to take time to visit each of these areas and the volunteer workers. As the church celebrates its 75th Anniversary it was nice to visit each spot and reflect back on its history.



The chapel was completed in 1947 and named after its first minister, the Rev. Dr. Will Hildebrand. Ten years later the Sanctuary and Sunday school building were completed in 1957 in the Old English Style architecture. Jordan Hall was named after Rev. Jordan Thatcher who served the church from 1949-1964. The church library is filled with books that mean so much to the members- including books on UM History, the scrapbook on the alter kneeling rail cushions, and a great bible library.

In the months ahead, let us continue to reflect on the wonderful history of the church. Let us also celebrate our present ministries and missions. This will guide us as we



dream and vision about the future as well. All these things begin with simple steps. Such as a small and dedicated group of volunteers who show up on a Saturday morning to help clean up the church. All are encouraged to attend any of the future work days: March 14, April 4, and May 2.
