As we move toward summer, we want to expand our interests and learn new information. Since all of us are getting older, we can read Amazing Grays by Leona and Richard Bergstrom. It offers many ideas for ministries by and for the aging. Perhaps, we could adopt some of them for Good Shepherd.

For those interested in health and medicines, read the Second 50 Years by the Institute of Medicine. This book appeals to those who have a background in health and medicine.

Healing can come in other way besides medicine and physicians. Barbara Brown Taylor's Gospel Medicine is a collection of her sermons which emphasize the healing power of God.
